



- ✓ Currently, Wikipedia had 3,810,842 articles in total (for the English version)

WIKIPEDIA & SEO

- ✓ Google loves Wikipedia
- ✓ Wikipedia dominate the SERPs
- ✓ Wikipedia is one of the most scrapped sites
- ✓ Wikipedia entry increases your brand presence
- ✓ Wikipedia increases brand credibility and reputation

- △ Vandalism
- △ Advertising
- △ Articles without reliable source
- △ Redundant
- △ Content not suitable for an encyclopedia


- ✓ Try editing existing articles

Create an account


- ✓ On the upper right corner, click the "Sign in/create account
- ✓ Enter the necessary information





Search Wikipedia


✓ You should search to check if the article already exists





Page not existing

✓ You may create the new page, but consider checking the search results to see whether the topic is already covered.





Creating New Page

- ✓ Provide a summary explaining the reasons for creating the new article
- ✓ Show preview to take a look at how the page will appear, and determine the necessary adjustments.
- ✓ Ensure to choose "watch this page" to monitor any recent edits to your page.






Adding image



Click on upload file (left side of the edit page)



- ✓ Only logged in user with auto confimed accounts can upload images
 - ✓ auto confirmed users: account is more than 4 days old *and* have made at least 10 edits

✓ click on the "edit" tab at the top of a Wikipedia You will be directed to the text box containing the editable text of the current page.






Preview Changes

 - ✓ For major edit: discuss the proposed changes on the article discussion/ talk page.



- ✓ Watchlist
 - Track changes edits via RSS feeds or via email alets
- ✓ Make regular and selfless edits
- ✓ Protect your page:
 - ✓ Users can request for a page to be protected to prevent vandalism
